



DOGGIE DAYCARE INFORMATION

Welcome to the Pack! Thank you for choosing Gunbarrel Veterinary Hospital for your Doggie Daycare and Boarding needs!

Here at Gunbarrel it is our mission to create a fun, safe environment for your dog to enjoy making new friends, getting exercise, and learning appropriate styles of play. We do not separate by size; therefore, certain behaviors are not allowed in order to ensure that everyone is safe and happy. If your dog is not feeling well (coughing, sneezing, vomiting, diarrhea) please keep them home for the safety and health of the other dogs in the yard.

Hours: Monday-Friday 7:45 am – 5:45 pm for walk in clients, no reservations are required for Doggie Daycare

Single Punch Card (buy 10 days get 1 free) \$428.00

Super Punch Card (buy 20 days get 5 free) \$854.95

Required Vaccines: Rabies, Distemper (DHPP) and Bordetella within the last 6 months. Vaccine records can be emailed to clientservices@gunbarrelvet.com.

Spay and Neuter: All dogs over 9 months are required to be spayed or neutered to attend Doggie Daycare. If your pup is showing signs of sexual maturity and/or other dogs in the daycare yard are bothering your pup, then we require your pup to be spayed or neutered before returning to Doggie Daycare.

Introduction: We want to make sure all our Daycare dogs are a good fit for our yard and that they will benefit from the Daycare experience. We introduce new dogs to at least 2 other regular Daycare attendees to see how the new dog reacts and to determine what their boundaries and limitations are. After the introduction is complete, we will call with an update and go over the introduction.

Drop off/Pick up: Doggie Daycare and Boarding drop off is located on the west side of the building at the green door. Please ring the doorbell and one of our staff will assist you. Dogs can be picked up at the front of the building at the Doggie Daycare pickup gate. A staff member will gather your dog's belongings and give you an update on how he/she did that day.

Weather: Daycare dogs will be rotated in and out, as needed, during extreme hot or cold weather days. We do have heaters in the winter and pools and misters in the summer months. All short haired, and small dogs are required to have a jacket or sweater on days it is 40 degrees or below.

Closures: During the holidays Doggie Daycare is closed to walk in clients. This is to ensure all boarding dogs get plenty of time in the Daycare yard and one on one time with our staff. See our Party and Holiday Closure schedule.
